Please complete at least one task per half term – we look forward to seeing your projects!

Science – Crush up a cereal like Cheerios, Shreddies or Special K and use a magnet to attract the iron in the cereal. This experiment teaches about magnetic properties, and also how Iron is included in foods like cereal to help us maintain healthy blood. Make a fact file about Iron (Fe) as both an element in the periodic table and essential to the biological processes of living things.

Geography and ICT – Investigate climate change in a chosen area of the world and create a powerpoint to present to the class. Please include adaptations that climate scientists and locals are making in that area e.g. protection against rising water levels and flooding

D&T – Look at home for toys or other items that have moving parts. Can you draw the moving parts and describe how they work?

PSHE – Make a leaflet or cartoon about how to reduce risks in the day-to-day life. You could think about risks around the home, risks when you're out and about and risks when you're online.

RE – Represent the Easter Story in a creative way... maybe a montage using Lego figures or toys? or perhaps with some special baking of breads or sweet treats at home.

Art – Create an image of a member of the royal family. Think about what art media you will use and how you will portray the person through the portrait.
