Science – With an adult, can you make an electromagnet at home? Take photos or a video of what you do and upload onto Seesaw or on a powerpoint. Or can you find ways to encourage your family to reduce their electricity consumption at home? Record what you did and create a photo journal of the changes you influenced on a powerpoint or Seesaw.

History – Ancient Civilisations (Ancient Greece): Paint or draw a piece of pottery in the style of the ancient Greeks.

Geography – Research a Greek island as a holiday destination. Make a poster or leaflet about why it is such a great place to visit and suggest activities to do there.

D&T – Research about different soups. Can you find recipes for soups from different countries? Look at the ingredients in different soups – either on cans of soup or recipes online. What ingredients are used in lots of different soups? Why are they used? Present your research either as a poster or leaflet.

ICT – Use a drawing tool on a tablet or laptop and draw a picture linked to your topic. Alternatively, draw a simple picture on paper which could be created only using the shape and line tools on the drawing apps.

Art – Using any medium, draw a famous building of your choice. See if we know what it is!
