Topic – please complete at least one task per half term

Science – Living Things and their Habitats: Create a poster for an endangered animal, showing its natural habitat. Persuade people about conservation. Investigate charities that work to support this animal and reference these on your poster.

History – Anglo-Saxons & Scots: Research an aspect of life; clothing, weapons, food, housing, ancient sites etc Visit West Stow or Sutton Hoo and produce a power point or visitors leaflet

Geography – Investigate trade routes around the world: How does our food get here – investigate the journey of one food item

ICT – Create a power point on any of the above topics. Insert photographs and images, use different fonts, animation and sound.

PSHE – Managing risk: When you are out and about on foot and in the car take a look at road signs you see. Discuss with an adult what they mean and how they help us manage risk

Art – Produce a natural sculpture in the style of Andy Goldsworthy or similar artist and photograph it.

D&T – Find out what ingredients grow in a particular country. Design a meal using these ingredients. You could make the meal and take some photos of it. Ask who you shared it with what they thought of it .
