South Cambs Schools Sports partnership including access to a PE specialist	£6700	To provide a model of outstanding PE lessons for KS1 staff who will have the opportunity to observe and collaborate with the PE specialist for at least 2 units of work. To improve PE teaching and overall fitness and engagement for all pupils. Implementing balanceability and mountain bike project, training new volunteers up to run sessions
Coach hire to SCSSP competitions and events	£1,500	To actively encourage participation in local sporting events
After school and lunch time activity club	£30 per hour x 38 weeks £1140	Club is free to all children. Certain children are actively encouraged to participate
Whole school swimming provision	Coach hire £1,200 Pool hire £800	Using off site swimming provision to enable all children to swim for one term.
Sports equipment and house team gazebos	£510 Gazebos £600	Sun covers for sports events Updating worn equipment
Chalk and line marker for field.	£300	To be self-sufficient in marking field for football, sports day and golden mile. Can also loan out to other local clubs and organisations
Bronze subscription to SCSSP	£850	Access to inter-school competitions, networking meetings and support from sports' partnership
Replacement of KS1 active track	£1900	Will enable daily, year round use of infant garden for balance bikes and other suitable equipment
Total	£6,300	Balance to be spent on various other sports initiatives such as sports trips, healthy eating sessions, clubs and visits from sporting professionals. Updating small apparatus for PE and Sensory Circuit sessions
